

Note to Users of The Congregation at Prayer 2019—2020 Master Schedule

The schedule that you have downloaded includes the typical material from the Bible-story lectionary, catechism schedule, Bible verses, and hymns from *Lutheran Catechesis: Catechist Edition*, that you have found in recent years.

We are currently developing an expansion of the Lutheran Catechesis Bible Story Lectionary that will include a second reading which will dovetail thematically with either the Bible story for the day, the catechism for the week, or the appropriate time in the church year. This second reading replaces readings from the LSB Lectionary for Daily Prayer. The second reading is shorter than what is available in the LSB lectionary and is an optional reading for individuals, couples, and families to use in their home devotions.

NOTE: The second reading option is completed only through week 11. From week 12 through the end of the summer, there are blank spaces for the second reading. All the other material for each week remains unchanged and is completed through the summer of 2020. It is our plan to continue to update this schedule as the year progresses. We will post updates to the master schedule here on the website, as well as weekly updates in the “Congregation at Prayer,” on our congregation’s main page at PeaceSussex.org.

NOTE: In an attempt to demonstrate the flexibility of the Three-Year-Bible Story lectionary and the other schedules in *Lutheran Catechesis*, this year there is a greater emphasis upon observing of Saints Days and minor festivals (typically one reading is chosen from the feast day to be read in addition to other readings for that day). Also, during Holy Week and Easter Week the appointed church-year readings from LSB are used. Schools who make use of this schedule during Holy Week or Easter Week may choose to read only a portion of these longer readings.
